THEOLOGY ROUNDTABLE continues our exploration of the teachings of St. Thomas Aquinas on the Nature of God. We've been at it for a few months now, and it seems likely that we'll be at it for a couple months more. But this should be no surprise, for the Nature of God is a pretty big subject. After all, just one aspect of that Nature is His infinity (which, like His simplicity, turns out to be entailed by His eternity); and the project of comprehending infinity can't be completed. Thus while we can comprehend any finite number of statements about God, and ascertain whether they are true, we cannot understand God Himself. Yet that understanding is our soul's deepest longing, which is why we engage in religion, and in theology. All are welcome at the Roundtable; no background in philosophy or theology is needed to profit from our discussions. We meet the second Wednesday of each month at 7:30 PM in Palache Hall. 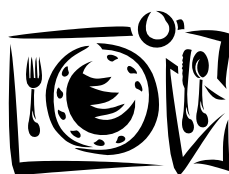

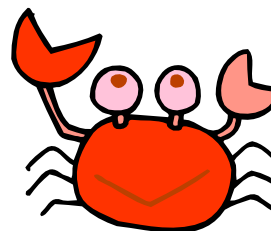

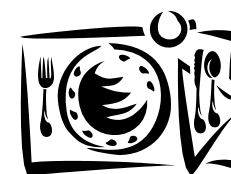
