**THEOLOGY ROUNDTABLE:** At our next session, we will begin discussing the moral philosophy of St. Thomas Aquinas. Our text is a distillation of St. Thomas' masterpiece, the *Summa Theologica*, a 3,000 page primer for novices in the study of theology at the University of Paris, where Aquinas taught. Catholic philosopher Peter Kreeft has assembled the most important arguments of the Summa into the 500 page *Summa of the Summa*. While we have been reading this book for quite a few months now, taking in the section on Ethics does not depend on first having learned everything that came before; so, just because you have not yet read any of the *Summa*, don't let that stop you. All are welcome at the Roundtable; no background in philosophy or theology is needed to profit from our discussions. We meet the second Wednesday of each month at 7:30 PM in Palache Hall. 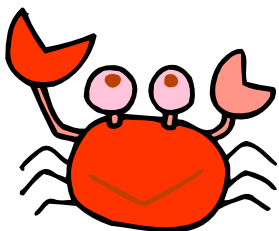

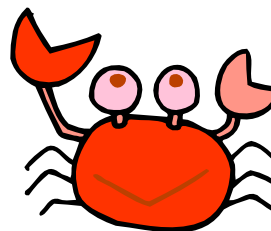

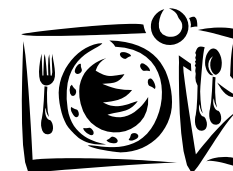
