ST. CLEMENT'S READING & DISCUSSION GROUP

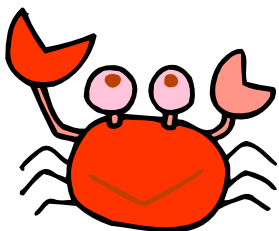
St. Clement's Reading and Discussion Group meets the 4th Tuesday of the month, at 6:30 PM in the conference room. We are known for serious reflection, sparkling conversation, and fabulous potluck and fellowship. You are welcome to join us. DAY BY DAY, a book of daily meditations for February, March and April, is now available at the back of the church and in Palache Hall.

THEOLOGY ROUNDTABLE: At our next session, we will begin discussing the moral philosophy of St. Thomas Aquinas. Our text is a distillation of St. Thomas' *Summa Theologica*, a 3,000 page primer for novices in theological study at the University of Paris. Catholic philosopher Peter Kreeft has assembled the most important arguments of the Summa into the 500 page *Summa of the Summa*. While we have been reading this book for quite a few months now, taking in the section on Ethics does not depend on first having learned everything that came before; so, just because you have not yet read any of the *Summa*, don't let that stop you. 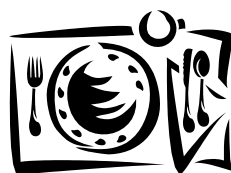

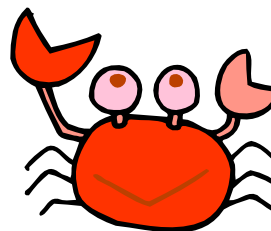

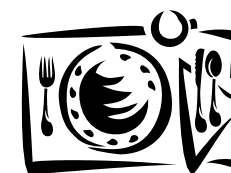
