**TODAY'S ORGAN MUSIC** is by the French organist-composer, Jehan Alain. Born 100 years ago on February 3, he was the older brother of legendary concert organist and scholar Marie-Claire Alain. Killed at age 29 while serving as a motorcycle dispatch rider during WWII, his short 10-year career leaves over 120 pieces of music. Considered one of the foremost 20<sup>th</sup> century organ composers, and one of the most innovative, his musical language was influenced by fellow Frenchmen Claude Debussy and Olivier Messiaen (composer of today's offertory anthem).
