### EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY

We are recruiting new members for the Education for Ministry (EfM) seminar. The recruiting season is May-June, although the 2011-2012 seminar will begin in early September. EfM combines the traditional functions of fellowship group and Bible study with a method of theological reflection, designed to help us make conscious connections between our faith traditions and the "post-religious" world we find ourselves in today.
